GLOSSARY

Term	Sub term	Definition
Address		Street address
Awaiting Tender Response		A tender has been submitted to a carrier and shipper is waiting for a response.
Bill of Lading (BOL)		A document that includes all of the details pertaining to a specific shipment. The BOL number can be generated by the WIN system, or user can assign their own number.
Carrier		Generic name for entity charged with actual physical transport of cargo
Carrier assigned		A carrier can be assigned to a shipment without tendering the load out. This can be done for reporting, or to save the information and tender at a later time.
Communication method	email	Tender is submitted via email.
Communication method	EDI	Tender is submitted via EDI (Electronic Data Interchange).
Communication method	Manual	Tender is accepted manually by the WIN user.
Delivery	Earliest	Earliest day and time for delivery
Delivery	Latest	Latest day and time for delivery
Delivery status	Relayed	Carrier has received the tender offer.
Destination		Ultimate point of delivery
Equipment		Type of ground equipment shipper requires
Equipment	LTV	Less than truckload Van. Contents will only fill part of a truck.
Equipment	FBL	Less Truckload Flatbed. Order will only fill part of a 48'
Equipment	SFB	Step Deck Flatbed. Similar to a standard flatbed, but the lower deck allows for hauling taller freight.
Equipment	FBD	Full Truckload Flatbed. Used for large cargo that does not fit or load easily into a 53 ft van truck
Equipment	Intermodal	Cargo leaves shipper by truck and is then transferred to rail. Cargo goes by rail to depot close to destination and then loaded onto truck and brought to final destination
Equipment	20C	20 ft Ocean Dray Container
Equipment	HTS	Hotshot, an expedited, dedicated move.
Handling unit		How the goods will be shipped; multiple packages can be combined in a handling unit. Length, width and height are required.

Hazmat		Indication of the hazardous nature of product

Location		Zip code, city, state, country
NMFC #		Classification provided to help carrier understand type of product in load
Operation	Request	Request for tender sent to carrier
Operation	Response	Carrier response to tender
Operation Status	Submitted	Tender submitted to carrier
Operation Status	Accepted	Carrier accepted tender
Order		Details of the shipment that needs to be moved
Order date		Date the order was created in WIN
Order number		Order tracking number generated by the WIN system
Origin		Where a shipment is shipped from
Package count		The number and types of packages the shipment will have
Payment Terms	Collect	Carrier will collect shipping fees from party receiving the cargo
Payment Terms	Customer Pickup	The shipment is paid for and scheduled with the customer's carrier of choice.
Payment Terms	Prepaid	Shipper pays the carrier in advance of shipping
Payment Terms	Third party	A third party, usually working on behalf of the shipper will pay the carrier
Pickup	Earliest	Earliest day and time for pickup
Pickup	Latest	Latest day and time for pickup
Pickup number		Customer assigned reference number for a shipment the carrier is to provide when picking up an order.
Product Class		Classification provided to help carrier understand type of product in load
Purchase order number		A number the shipper creates and inputs into WIN for reporting/tracking
Ready to tender		Order has been created but not submitted for tendering
Sales order number		A number the shipper creates and inputs into WIN for reporting/tracking
Ship direction	Outbound	Client ships product to another party
Ship direction	Inbound	Another party ships to client
Shipment mode		Current default in ground

Site Name		Name of site
SKU/Product number		Designation provided by shipper to report on products
Special Services		Service shipper requires in addition to basic transportation of cargo
Stackable		Indication if the units can be stacked on top of each other
Tender		Presentation of an offer from a shipper to a carrier to enter into a contract
Tender Accepted		Carrier has agreed to take the load
Tender Cancelled		Shipper cancelled the tender to the carrier.
Tender Declined		Carrier is unable to pickup the load.
Tendered		Carrier has been offered the load.
